

AFter the sixth round in Zuera (E) at the WSK International Series everything has been arranging for the final rush for the titles still to be awarded. The KZ2 EuroCup belongs to Intrepid, while Tony Kart J.T. leads both KF2 and KF3. In Super KF CRG takes the lead with Cesetti first in drivers ranking.

Zuera (E), september 30th 2009

FROM ZUERA IT COMES AWAY THE FIRST WSK CHAMPIONS. Opened two seasons ago just with a WSK round, the circuit in Zuera (E) baptized this year the first champions of 2009 International Series. Last Sunday, in the last round but one, besides drivers rankings, the challenges in EuroCup held the stage as well, at a crucial moment in season's ending.

THE FIRST TO BE TRIUMPHANT IS INTREPID IN KZ2. Bas Lammers' ride, incoming KZ2 Champion, as well as Jeremy Iglesias brought Intrepid Kart Technology to the top in EuroCup. The two drivers are placed respectively first and third in the championship ranking, dominating a podium where Marco Ardigò (Tony Kart Racing Team) was a good second. Rick Dreezen improved the position of his team CRG Holland thanks to a good performance joining in the head to head between the two Italian teams: the one from Salizzole, Verona, and the white-green team from Prevalle, Brescia, that arrived in Zuera separated by only 1-point gap. The Dutch team however, failed to achieve the Championship podium that CRG Spa retained firmly, below Intrepid and Tony Kart.

OVERTAKING AT THE TOP IN SUPER KF. CRG HAS THE LEAD. Brandon Maisano's winning debut (LH chassis, entered by CRG Spa), complemented by Kozlinski mounting the podium, was useful to CRG Spa for overtaking the previous leader Birel Motorsport, in EuroCup. From the odds, the challenge for the ultimate win is narrowed down to these two teams, whereas Maranello Kart and Tony Kart Racing Team are the favourite for the chase for the podium. As for Drivers title, the ranking is still open, with Cesetti (Birel) who is still leading over Kozlinski.

TONY KART JUNIOR TEAM GOES FOR KF2 TITLE. Ben Cooper already scored a hit, winning KF2 Drivers ranking, in Zuera. His team, Tony Kart Junior Team will go to Lonato aiming to round the season off with the EuroCup win. In the ranking, Paul Spencer's team is over Energy Corse, the only team that may still compete for the victory. Below, the third place is at stake between Tony Kart R.T. and MGM Racing.

TRIPLE SPRINT IN KF3, TONY KART J.T. IS AT THE TOP. Tony Kart Junior Team leads KF3 EuroCup as well; the same class Dutch Nick De Vries has already won Drivers title. Chiesa Corse, the team the Dutch driver drive for, may aim at improving, as well as Morsicani Racing that has still chances of winning.
